


As usual it has been a busy month at AWOL in Luxor. We continue to treat hundreds of animals and make improvements at the centre. Hector received extra special attention over the last few weeks as we fitted his new prosthetic foot. It is too early to tell if this is a long-term solution but he has been walking on four feet again so we hope this is the start of his recovery. We are continuing to look at various solutions to find the best one. At the moment he is having time both with and without the prosthetic to overcome the problems of breathability of the foot in the high temperatures in Luxor. He can now be exercised on four feet to build up his leg muscles and help keep his spine straight.

Many thanks to Georgie Hollis and Professor Derek Knottenbelt for their help with Hector. It is hoped Georgie will be able to visit Hector personally early next year. A huge thanks as always to our supporters whose support has enabled us to continue to treat the animals in Luxor. We wish you all a very happy Christmas and a peaceful New Year. The team at the AWOL centre in Luxor will still be caring for the west bank animals over the Christmas period for which we thank them very much.






The little dog who came in with such a horrific face wound a few weeks ago has been back to the centre and is looking amazingly good. When he was first brought in he had exposed facial bones. It's great to see such a complete recovery from such a bad injury.



This poor little puppy came in with horrible red swollen eyes which looked very painful. This was the result of being sprayed in the face by a snake.

Luckily the little dog will be fine after undergoing extensive eye flushing at the AWOL



centre so he should be back to normal soon; but will probably have learnt to keep away from snakes in the future!



This lovely cat with beautiful blue eyes came in for flea and tick treatment so she is relatively healthy. The other cat may not be so lucky as he has ingested some poison and although he has survived he may in future suffer from kidney problems as a result.



This sweet little dog is Lucky 2; he is a lovely gentle little dog just over a year old. Some of you might remember him from last year when he was a little puppy. He was rehomed from the centre to a home in Karnak. Unfortunately the man who had given Lucky a home had to leave the area for work and although he had made care provisions for Lucky it was felt he wasn't receiving quite as much care as needed so he is being looked after at AWOL for a few days until he is ready for his new home. A quiet village home has been found for him where we hope he will be well looked after and we will be checking up on him after he has settled in.



Another repeat visitor at the centre; This horse with the deep muscle and ligament damage has been back for further treatment and check-ups. The flesh is now knitting back over the wound and he is able to put his foot on the ground. This was such a deep wound he is very lucky to still have the use of his leg.
